80 years since the end of World War II, 40 years since the declaration of Peace City = Convey, Pray, and Connect =

It has been 80 years since the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki and the end of the war. It will be 40 years since the city declared the "Peace City Declaration", calling for the abolition of nuclear weapons to protect the lives and safety of citizens and prevent a repetition of the horrors of the past. In fiscal 2025, when the city will mark each of these milestones, we will work on commemorative projects such as having "Abiko Peace Day," to hold peace-related events and producing "Peace Songs".

◆ Cranes folded by Sadako

A precious origami crane folded by Sadako Sasaki during her lifetime is on permanent display at Abista. She is the model for the "Children of the Atomic Bomb" statue in Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park. The paper crane was donated by Sadako's brother, Masahiro and her nephew, Yuji, who sympathized with the city's peace project. Sadako, who suffered from leukemia after the atomic bombing, folded cranes using medicine and caramel wrappers, hoping to "live".
